Collected and sent to Ukraine (June-July) -1st campaign:

Arm crutches -183

Braces and supports - 11

Perching stool - 6

Rollator – 20

Scooter - 2

Toilet Aids - 9

Walking stick – 50

Wheelchair - 11

Zimmer frame - 24

Camping - 29

Other -10

Total - 375 items.



2nd campaign started in September and there are some results:

175 items have been sent to Sumy already.

861 items are catalogued (1286 kg) and we are still collecting things.

Gathering: Drop-in coffee mornings

11 May, 21 June, 13 July, 21 July, 10 August, 17 August, 14 September, 12 October, 19 October, 09 November, 30 November (Shoreham, Worthing)

The aim is to hear from the first hands about all issues, answer questions, signpost to the right services, and support people.



Linking with our MP, Tom Rutland and Beccy Cooper.

We, and our partners CW and W4R organised 2 meetings in person with our local MPs

We have 2 pressing concerns we wish to address:

The visa programme needs to be bought forward to allow those women and children
who were the first to arrive to start applying as soon as possible in order to avoid loss of
employment and loss of housing. Many of these people are also coming to the end of
tenancy agreements which require further 12 month contracts or are about to move into
accommodation on 12 month contracts, which is not possible at this stage and
therefore are at risk of homelessness.

Employment arrangements will now start to be impacted as employers will be reluctant to offer roles to people on ambiguous visa arrangements. This will also have implications on accommodation.

2. <u>Tackling the length of the visa</u> - 18 months appears not to be adequate especially for those people wishing to continue their education or improve their employment prospects. We would like to see a request for longer visas being issued.



Dancing Group I was invited as a guest to other Ukrainian celebrations, such as Ivana Kupala, Ukrainian Independence Day, Royal British Legion Remembrance Day at Worcester Park, St Mary's Church, Goring - International event, Worthing Festival, International Neighbours at Shoreham Centre, International Friends at Clifton Community Church, Worthing, Vyshyvanka Day in Brighton.






